Access to Ennismore Fund Management

Ennismore Fund Management can be accessed either from Kensington Church Walk or from 5 Kensington Church Street. There is an Ennismore intercom at both these entrances.

5 Kensington Church Street Entrance – This entrance is shared with the shop “Petit Bateau”. There is a brass board in the entrance lobby with an Ennismore buzzer. Visitors should walk down the corridor and follow the path around the corner and down some steps to Ennismore Fund Management.

Kensington Church Walk Entrance – There are black iron gates set in an archway underneath a house just past the churchyard. On the left hand side of the gates there is a brass plaque with an Ennismore buzzer.

Tube Stations

Kensington High Street (Circle and District lines) is approximately a three minute walk. The entrance to Kensington Church Walk is directly opposite Marks & Spencer, next to The Ivy restaurant.

Notting Hill Gate (Circle, District & Central lines) is approximately a ten minute walk. After exiting the tube station, head east and turn right next to Waterstone's, heading south down Kensington Church Street.

Car Parking

There are some meters in neighbouring streets, but the best option is to use one of the car parks shown on the map.

Chauffeur driven cars can stay in the non-pedestrian bit of Kensington Church Walk, accessed from Holland Street.

* It is possible for chauffeur driven cars to wait here.
